

NC State Fair Public House Job Description: Contracted Workers

The North Carolina Craft Brewers Guild is seeking individuals to work at the NC Public House at the North Carolina State Fair. This is a short term job, running from October 12th - 22nd, 2023. The NC Public House is located on the NC State Fairgrounds in Raleigh, in the Dorton Arena South Lobby. Staff will be responsible to perform a variety of duties per shift, as described below.

Note: This is a contracted job (Form 1099-MISC) and hired contractors will <u>not</u> be considered employees of the NC Craft Brewers Guild. Independent contractors will be responsible for their own tax reporting and payment, and are not eligible for company benefits.

Hourly Wage: \$20 per hour

- Payment will be issued in full upon completion of the job, per contract terms.
- Overtime hours will not be available for this position.
- Travel to and from the event site is not compensated (parking will be provided.)

Job Dates: October 12th - 22nd, 2023

- Hired workers may be asked to attend an orientation on October 10th or 11th, 2023.

Requirements:

- All workers must be 18+ years of age, unless otherwise approved.
- All workers must be either RASP or Serv-Safe certified.
- All workers must have reliable transportation to and from work.
- All workers must be able to stand for extended periods, and lift up to 60lbs.
- A background check may be required.

Primary Responsibilities:

This job will include working a combination of the following activities:

• Crowd Monitoring:

- Help create a friendly and welcoming environment for NC Public House guests
- Monitor crowds and answer customer questions.
- Keep all areas clean and maintain trash pick-up.

• ID Checking:

 Examine the ID of every guest who enters the Public House to verify the guest is of legal drinking age. Attention to detail is critical while ID checking.

Cashier:

- Process cash or card payments using a POS system to sell beverage tickets
- o Process a cash transaction with correct change due, when needed.

• Serving (Must be 18+ years of age.)

- Manage the safe service of alcoholic beverages at the Beer + Wine Counter.
- Confirm that the customer is not intoxicated and is of legal drinking age at time of service.

Bar Support:

- Keep the bar area clean, and trash & recycling emptied.
- o Ensure the bar area is stocked with ice, cups and product at all times.
- Maintain product inventory management and help move kegs.

All staff will assist with either opening or closing preparations, depending on the shift.

Additional Requirements:

- All staff must attend one of the required orientation programs prior to working.
- All staff are required to adhere to local, state, & federal public health & safety mandates.
- Overtime hours are not available for this position. Please plan your schedule accordingly.
- Staff will be responsible for providing their own drinks, snacks, & meals.
- Staff will be provided with a 30 minute break during each shift.
- Staff will be expected to check-in and check-out with the on-site manager at the start and end of each shift.
 - Paid hours begin at check-in and end at check-out (does not include travel time.)
- The Guild will provide staff t-shirts. Staff should plan on changing into their shirt on-site, and returning it at the end of their shift, to be laundered for the next day's shift.
