

Hurricane Helene Grant Assistance

+ Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Individual and Household Program (IHP):

This program provides financial assistance to eligible homeowners and renters who suffered damage or losses due to Hurricane Helene. It can cover temporary housing, home repairs, and replacement of essential items. To apply for FEMA assistance, visit https://www.disasterassistance.gov/ or call 1-800-621-FEMA (3362).

+ Small Business Administration (SBA) Disaster Loan Program:

Coverage: This program offers low-interest disaster loans to businesses, homeowners, and renters affected by Hurricane Helene. Loans can be used to repair property damage, replace inventory, and cover operating expenses.
