

Local Orders for COVID-19

Below is a listing of local orders & details that we are aware of at this time...

Town of Beaufort: A <u>stay-at-home order for the Carteret County town</u> on the coast went into effect Wednesday until April 22. <u>Beaufort FAQs</u>

Buncombe County: A "Stay Home, Stay Safe Supplemental Declaration" to an existing local state of emergency will go into effect 8pm, March 26 until April 9.

Durham County/City of Durham: The mayor of Durham <u>issued a stay-at-home order</u> that goes into effect 3/25 at 6pm – 4/30. Durham FAQ.

Cabarrus County: A <u>stay-at-home proclamation</u> goes into effect 3/26 at 5pm – indefinite. The order includes the city of Concord and the towns of Harrisburg, Midland and Mt. Pleasant. It also includes Kannapolis, in both Cabarrus and Rowan counties.

Clemmons (Village of): A <u>Second Declaration of State of Emergency Shelter in Place Order</u> is in effect 3/27 at 5pm - 4/16.

Greenville (City of): Has issued its <u>Third Proclamation of Emergency - COVID-19</u> in effect 3/26 at 5pm – 4/10. <u>FAQ</u>

Guilford County: County officials announced a <u>stay-at-home order</u> The order goes into effect at 5 p.m. Friday. <u>Greensboro - FAQ</u>

Lexington (City of): Has issued a <u>Stay at Home recommendation and city-wide public safety curfew</u> in effect Saturday, March 28, 2020 at 9:00pm. The curfew is daily from 9:00pm to 5:00am March 28, 2020 through Saturday, April 18, 2020 midnight.

Madison County: Issued a <u>shelter-in-place</u> recommendation on March 23.

Mecklenburg County/Charlotte: County commissioners <u>issued a stay-at-home order</u> that took effect at 8 a.m. Thursday. The order includes Charlotte.

Orange County: A <u>stay-at-home order</u> goes into effect Friday, 3/27 at 6pm – 4/30 at 5pm.

Pitt County: Issued a stay-at-home order that went into effect at 5 p.m on 3/25 – 4/8.

The city of Greenville in Pitt County issued a <u>"stop the spread" order</u> that begins at 5 p.m. Thursday until April 10.

Wake County/Raleigh: Issued a <u>stay-at-home order</u> that goes into effect Friday, March 27th at 5pm. <u>Guidance for Wake Co. businesses</u>.

Winston-Salem: Issued a <u>stay-at-home order</u> starting Friday at 5 p.m. Violators will be charged with a misdemeanor. The order, signed by the mayor, is in effect until April 16.
